**Motion:** Kirk/Wood to approve and pay with check #69 to Keller Engineers in the amount of \$72,888.66. Motion passed without objection.

Guest Kuzar asked if there was still iron in the water. She showed Engineer Cunningham a picture of the American Legion commode with brown water. She stated that she noticed the Sulphur was there last week or the week before and it smelled. Engineer Cunningham stated that Hastings was on our wells from the weekend before Thanksgiving to the following weekend. They were on our system for about two weeks. It could have been caused by Well #2. Or it could also be from deposits that were out in the line were getting stirred up (in the old lines). Guest Kuzar asked which well we are currently using. Engineer Cunningham stated that mostly Well #3 is being used, and Well #2 is being used occasionally. Guest Kuzar stated that something is wrong because the smell of her water is still there, and she noticed brown water last night. Vice Chairman Wood stated that they did fill the tanker from the Fire Company last night and that could be why she had brown water.

Chairman Link asked Engineer Cunningham why Hastings fill their tank halfway. Engineer Cunningham replied they are trying to rotate their water better.

Engineer Cunningham asked guest Kuzar how often you notice the brown water at her place. Guest Kuzar replied every day.

General discussion took place regarding water tank rods.

Guest Kuzar asked if the water tests are still being done.

Secretary Dunegan replied that all of the tests are still put on the Borough website.

More discussion took place.

Guest Kuzar added that Mr. Ault told her that he has very low water pressure. Secretary Dunegan stated to have him call the Borough office tomorrow, and the Borough Crew can go take a look at it.
