He stated that a public meeting was held in January with East Carroll Township residents (35 Attended). Rich Wray did give the Authority the new map which includes six customers that need to connect on James Avenue. The plans were sent in for an archeology review. The flow plans are 400 gallons per day per customer, which totals 20,000 gallons a day for the total use. It has the same plans as it did in 2008.


**Motion:** Wood/Shilling to approve executing the planning documents as presented by Mr. Wray at this evening meeting. Motion passed without objection.
