

Patton Municipal Authority
Regular Meeting
Minutes
January 27, 2021

Location: Patton Borough Council Chambers

Member Present: Chairman, Edwin Link; Vice Chairman, Pat Wood. Members: Don Kirk, Fred Shilling,; PT Business Manager, Donna Dunegan and Recording PMA Secretary, Amanda Farrell. Guest: David Cunningham, Keller Engineers. Absent: Jay Weakland

Chairman Link opened the meeting at 5PM.

Engineer Dave Cunningham stated that he submitted a multimodal grant application for Patton Borough for Magee Avenue. In order to apply for the PennVest Grant in February the Borough would need to prove there is lead in the lines, have a design and have all the permitting done before applying. General discussion took place on different grant applications.

Water Line Replacement Project – Engineer Dave Cunningham stated PennVest is estimated to give out around \$96 million. Patton Borough does not have any lead service lines that need replaced. The Borough does have some cast iron pipes that will qualify to be eliminated for this project. Everyone that applies for this is going to receive the same amount, no matter how many applicants apply. It will depend on the number of applications they receive. Engineer Cunningham stated that Patton is a legitimate project and a good candidate for this project. The MultiModal grant application will be announced sometime in the summer as to who all receives that. General discussion took place regarding this matter.

Motion: Wood/Kirk to approve Patton Municipal Authority Resolution #2021 – 01-01 -A Resolution of the Patton Municipal Authority authorizing to submit a Financial Assistance Application to the Pennsylvania Infrastructure Investment Authority (PennVest), substantially in the form that the PennVest grant to fix the water/sewer lines for Magee Avenue. Application for Financial Assistance (“application”) in the amount of \$600,000.00 from the Pennsylvania Infrastructure Investment Authority (“Authority”) to the Patton Municipal Authority, Cambria County (“Applicant”) for the Improvement of a drinking water system in Patton Borough, Cambria County, Commonwealth of Pennsylvania (“Project”) presented at this meeting for the purpose of financing the rehabilitation of a drinking water distribution line along Magee Avenue, Patton Borough. Appropriate officers of the governing body are hereby authorized to execute all certificates and documentation required in connection with the application. Motion passed without objection.
